Use ICT as a way of producing animal art work.

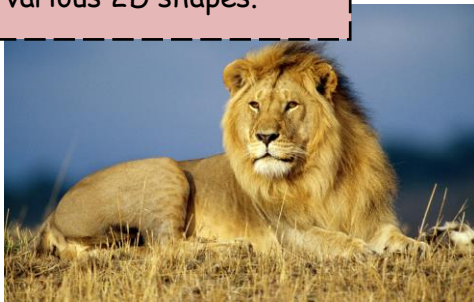
## Maths
