

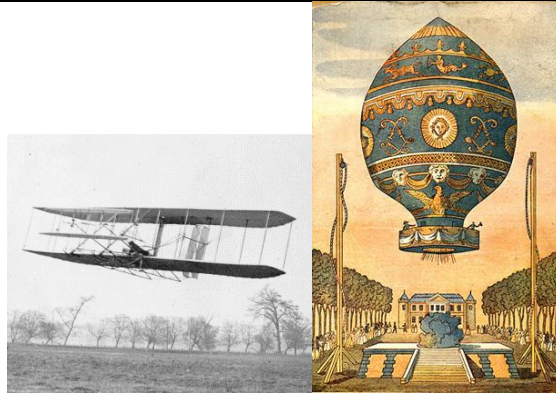
# Sharnbrook Primary Knowledge Planner - Year 1 History
